What Makes Bahamas Dolphins So Special

Bimini is home to some of the most curious and social wild Atlantic spotted and bottlenose dolphins in the world.

Here, the water is clear, calm, and impossibly blue. Encounters happen naturally, on their terms — and when they choose you, it's a magical experience.

Over the years, I've witnessed moments that stay forever:

- Eye contact
- Dolphins chasing you for fun
- Watching them hunt, flirt, and communicate
- The buzz of their echolocation scanning your body
- Tiny calves learning to play
- Playing fetch with dolphins with a shirt

It's this mix of clarity, curiosity, and wild freedom that makes Bimini one of the most magical places on Earth to swim with dolphins.



What We'll Experience Together



For four days, we'll be out on the water searching through that endless Bahamian blue for wild dolphins.

We head out in the afternoons, when the chances of finding them are highest. These are fully wild animals, so nothing can ever be guaranteed — but Bimini's success rate is remarkable, around 80-90%.


Once we find them, we'll slip into

the water and enjoy whatever they choose to share.

Every interaction is unique: sometimes playful, sometimes calm, sometimes curious beyond belief. We never know what they'll be up to — and that unpredictability is part of the magic.

Dolphins are the heart of this journey, but the ocean here offers so much more.





What We'll Experience Together




During the mornings, we'll explore a variety of ocean experiences:

- swimming with gentle wild stingrays
- snorkeling with sharks and visiting a beautiful wreck where turtles often appear
- touring a shark research lab to learn about the ongoing science on the island
- visiting the iconic dolphin museum

We'll also soak in Bahamian culture, enjoy local food, and spend time on beaches that truly feel like some of the most beautiful in the world.

This is a complete ocean experience.





Itinerary Overview

Day 1— Arrival & First Dolphin Search

Arrive in Bimini, settle in, have lunch and expedition briefing.
Afternoon: our first dolphin search.

Day 2 — Stingrays & Dolphins

Morning: swim with wild stingrays in shallow turquoise water.
Afternoon: dolphin search — every encounter different.

Day 3— Sharks, Wreck & Dolphins

Morning: snorkel with reef sharks and explore the Sapona wreck.
Afternoon: dolphin search — more magic.

Day 4 — Shark Lab, Dolphin Museum & Dolphins

Morning: visit the shark research lab + the island's dolphin museum.
Afternoon: final dolphin search — our closing experience in the blue.

Day 5 — Departure

Slow morning, last swim or beach walk, heart full of ocean.

We'll share all our meals together as a group, and throughout the trip I will share talks on dolphins, conservation, freediving, and any ocean topics the group feels called to explore.

Where We Stay




Our home base in Bimini is a comfortable hotel right next to the dive center, making our daily departures easy and relaxed.

You'll share a double room with another guest — each person has their own bed, and every room includes a private bathroom for comfort and privacy.

The hotel has a pool to relax and it's where we'll enjoy our group breakfasts before heading out for each day's adventure. There's also beautiful beaches in just a short walk.

Getting There



By air from Florida, USA

There are direct flights from Fort Lauderdale and Miami, which takes about 35 min. Fly into North Bimini Airport (NSB) and then take a 10 min taxi ride to Big Game Club Hotel. It's super easy (the airport is tiny - just a seaplane base - and there are taxis all the time) and not expensive (about \$5 usd per person CASH), no need to schedule. Take an earlier flight. We'll meet for lunch on the hotel at 12 and then have our expedition briefing. The hotel will hold our bags and we'll check in when we come back from the tour around 5pm.

Taking the Ferry from Florida to Bimini

You can also take a ferry (Balearia Caribbean) from Port Everglades, Ft Lauderdale to Bimini. It takes about 2h and once you arrive the process is the same as arriving by plane (short easy ride, no need to book in advance, \$5 usd CASH).





How to Join the Waitlist?



Joining this expedition is simple — and the waitlist is how you get priority.

Click on the reserve your spot button on the [website page \(link here\)](#). Click on Join the Waitlist. Once I open the date you will be the first to receive a booking link (before the public launch)

Public Launch is November 24 at 12:00 PM (MST time).

If any spots remain after the waitlist period, they'll be released to the public on this date.

This process gives priority to past guests and people who truly feel called to this trip, while keeping the experience intimate and aligned.

Only 7 spots are available — joining the waitlist is the best way to make sure you don't miss your chance. The first date was sold out in less than 48 hours.

Here is the payment process:

First Payment (Deposit): \$1,500 usd to secure your spot

Final payment: \$2,000 usd 60 days before initial date.

Experience Needed

You don't need to know freediving or scuba to join this trip — this is a snorkel-based experience. But you do need to feel comfortable swimming, as we'll spend plenty of time in the water.

Bimini offers amazing conditions: warm, shallow water (5–12 m / 15–40 ft), excellent visibility.

If you're a freediver, that's a huge plus — dolphins often get curious when we move smoothly underwater. But it's not required at all.

What matters most is your attitude: come with gratitude, curiosity, and no expectations. The ocean gives us something different every day — and that's part of the magic.




As a freediving instructor and marine biologist, you will learn from me about freediving techniques that will help you have more intimate interactions with the dolphins, as well as about their biology and conservation.
